## Program 1 – Genesis: Folding the 3<sup>rd</sup> Dimension [at] Pollack Mihály University

**Monday, October 4, 2010 + Tuesday, October 5, 2010**

Folding of chairs with students

## Program 2 – Flash Mob [at] Széchenyi Square

**Wednesday, October 6, 2010, Noon**

Pupils of the Nagy Lajos Gymnasium carry the chairs to the Széchenyi Square, remain seated for a while and disappear slowly back to school

## Program 3 – Tri-national Opening [at] Széchenyi Square

**Wednesday, October 6, 2010, Afternoon:**

Tri-national Opening of "2010 Chairs" with friends and colleagues from the German and Turkish Temporary City teams

## Program 4 – Psycho Geography [at] Vasarely Tér

**Thursday, October 7, 2010, Noon/Afternoon**

Tri-national Walk from Széchenyi Square to Vasarely Tér, 48 AS Tér and Káptar Library. 200 Chairs will be set up by participants to navigate pedestrians onto the path to the new cultural premises

## Program 5 – Anarchistic Playground [at] 48 - As – Tér

**Friday, October 8, 2010, Afternoon**

Out of the masses of chairs, kids can personalize their own one before spatial activities under the observation of teachers and volunteers take place, creating bizarre impressions while the installation is transforming and transforming....

## Program 6 – The Non-Conform System [at] Káptar Library Parking Lot

**Saturday, October 9, 2010, Morning**

In the area of tension of a never used parking lot, the ambiguity of the chair comes to action. In a dichotomy between conformity and non-conformity. Establish the Perfect Square with a 109 degree twist.

## Program 7 – Party in Periphery [at] Káptar Library Parking Lot

**Saturday, October 9, 2010, Evening / Night**

An illuminated parking lot – a former no-man's-land – without cars, but chairs, the set for the night – a party taking place in the periphery. Far beyond mainstream, rather a diffuse atmosphere with avant-garde sounds to create the finale, where no one remains seated

**Sunday, October 10, 2010, Noon**
